

Who is the Mini Rugby Referee course for?

The Mini Rugby Referee course is an entry level programme and is aimed at those who referee / game coach mini rugby festivals, up to primary 7 age group.

You must be minimum 14 years of age to complete the course. This course is not mandatory to referee mini rugby.

What is covered on the course?

The Mini Rugby Referee course aims to equip people with the fundamental refereeing skills and tools at a mini rugby level.

By the end of the programme you will...

- Understand the age grade law variations and how to apply them in a game context.
- Promote player welfare and manage player behaviours during a game
- Appreciate the principles of mini rugby refereeing

How long is the course?

The Mini Rugby Referee course will be a four hour course, delivered using practical and theoretical modules.

MINIMUM MINI RUGBY MATCH OFFICIAL STANDARDS 2020/21
