

# Scottish Rugby DEBENTURES Season 2023/24



### FIVE GAMES AT BT MURRAYFIELD NEXT SEASON











With the Rugby World Cup being played in France from late September to the end of October, Scotland's usual Autumn Nations Series games will not take place this year.

Instead, fans have the chance to come to BT Murrayfield during the summer and watch three Tests as part of the Scotland Rugby World Cup squad's tournament preparations before flying out to Nice in the south of France ahead of their opening pool game.



### **VITALY**

### Saturday 29 July

The fast-improving Italy team recorded eye-catching wins last year against Wales at the Principality Stadium on the last weekend of the Guinness Six Nations, and at home against Australia in the Autumn Nations Series. The team is bursting with flair - their exhilarating young full-back Ange Capuozzo won World Rugby's Breakthrough Player of the Year award last year – and sets up fans with the perfect start to the Summer Test series.

### **V FRANCE**

### Saturday 5 August

Rugby World Cup 2023 hosts France went through the whole of last year unbeaten, finishing with a win against the current World Champions, South Africa. This is the first of two games against les Bleus this August – they play again the following weekend in France (venue tbc) – and provides the perfect opportunity to see this popular fixture played in glorious summer weather.

### **v GEORGIA**

### Saturday 26 August

Last summer Georgia beat Italy and ran an Argentine XV close, then narrowly lost to Samoa in the Autumn Nations Series before travelling to Cardiff and beating Wales for the first time. The Scots played Georgia home and away in the Summer of 2019 ahead of the last Rugby World Cup, the game at BT Murrayfield in front a crowd of over 53,000, a record for the fixture and the second-highest ever for a Summer Test. Come and give the Scotland players a rousing send-off in their last game before flying out to the Rugby World Cup!

### Do NOT sell your tickets on the secondary market!

Season Passes and match tickets are NOT permitted to be transferred or sold (or offered for transfer or sale) through any secondary ticketing service provider, auction site or website. Any passes or tickets found to be offered for sale on any secondary site will be contravening our ticketing Terms & Conditions and will be cancelled and made void. Anyone found to be selling passes or tickets in direct contravention of the ticketing T&Cs will be subject to appropriate sanctions and may be prevented from purchasing any further passes or tickets.

### **Debenture Hospitality**

Murrayfield "C" and "D - Thistle" Debenture holders are offered the opportunity to purchase the official debenture hospitality packages at all games. Packages, which usually start around three hours before kick off and finish an hour after the final whistle, generally include a 3 course meal, drinks before and after the game and food post-match. Hospitality for C Debentures will be located onsite, suite dependant on demand. D debenture hospitality is in the Thistle Suite. Package pricing is available on request.
