# Autumn Nations Series 2024

The Autumn Nations Series returns to Scottish Gas Murrayfield this year (there was no series last year because of Rugby World Cup) and Scotland fans can look forward to four fantastic games, including a welcome return from the current World Champions South Africa, and a first ever visit from the team that dazzled fans at last year's Rugby World Cup in France.

# v FIJI

#### Saturday 2 November, 5.40pm

Always an entertaining game against the popular South Sea Islanders, Scotland scored four tries the last time the Flying Fijians came to Scottish Gas Murrayfield. Having famously beaten England in the build-up to last year's Rugby World Cup, Fiji went on to beat Australia in the tournament itself before being knocked out at the quarter-final stage. A fantastic game to kick off this year's Autumn Nations Series.

# Sunday 10 November, 4.10pm

# Guinness Six Nations 2025

Scotland kick off the 2025 Guinness Six Nations Championship with two home games. First up is Italy on Saturday 1 February, kick-off 2.15pm (with the following game Ireland v England on the big screen in the West Fan Village afterwards) then the following weekend we welcome Ireland to Scottish Gas Murrayfield (Sunday 9 February, kick-off 3pm). The final home game is against Wales on Saturday 8 March, kick-off 4.45pm (with the Ireland v France on in the West Fan Village beforehand).

# **VITALY**

Saturday 1 February, 2.15pm

The last time Italy came to Scottish Gas Murrayfield, a Blair Kinghorn hat-trick helped Scotland to a 26-14 win. This season's two-point loss in Rome (despite out-scoring Italy 4 tries to 3) will act as an extra motivator to kick-off the 2025 Guinness Six Nations in winning style.

Anyone found to be selling passes or tickets in direct contravention of the ticketing T&Cs will be subject to appropriate sanctions and may be prevented from purchasing any further passes or tickets.

# **Debenture Hospitality**

Murrayfield "C" and "D - Thistle" Debenture holders are offered the opportunity to purchase the official debenture hospitality packages at all games. Packages, which usually start around three hours before kick off and finish an hour after the final whistle, generally include a 3 course meal, drinks before and after the game and food post-match. Hospitality for C Debentures will be located onsite, suite dependant on demand. D debenture hospitality is in the Thistle Suite. Package pricing is available on request.
