- Stakeholder and fulfilment management with rugby partners and sponsors including but not limited to; Scottish Rugby, Peebles HS, Team sponsors.

- Delivery of the Peebles RFC Academy programmes managing individual player development, including skills and S&C support, and transition programmes at all ages and stages.
