Member Requisitions

Members holding not less than 5% of the voting rights (currently equating to at least 8 full member clubs or associated bodies) may requisition a general meeting and include a resolution within that. If you wish to requisition a meeting – which would be held as a special general meeting – to take place on the same day as the AGM, the relevant documentation will need to be submitted no earlier than Wednesday 9th October 2024 and no later than Monday 4th November 2024.

A meeting requisition must state the general nature of the business to be dealt with at the general meeting and can include the text of a resolution that may be properly moved at the meeting.

The process for this and for resolutions at company meetings more generally are subject to a number of statutory requirements under the Companies Act 2006 which differ from those under the former Union's Bye-Laws.
