NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

The traditional Scotland games at Scottish Gas Murrayfield every November, known previously as the Autumn Tests or Quilter Nations Series, will still be played at the same time this year, but now make up the second half of the new global international tournament called the Nations Championship. The world's best teams from the Northern and Southern Hemispheres go head-to-head across two connected series (the first three rounds replace the old Summer Tours) culminating in a Finals Weekend being played in London.

Nations Championship: Round 3

SCOTLAND v FIJI

Saturday 18 July (KO tbc)

The Flying Fijians are playing their three 'home' games in the opening rounds of this year's Nations Championship in the UK: against Wales (Round 1) in Cardiff; England (Round 2) in Liverpool; and finally, their Round 3 match against Scotland at Scottish Gas Murrayfield. Although Scotland beat Fiji 57-17 at the same venue two years ago, the last time the two teams met – in Suva last summer – the hosts won 29-14.

Nations Championship: Round 4

SCOTLAND v NEW ZEALAND

Saturday 7 November (Kick-off 2.10pm)

Ranked number two in the world, New Zealand were runners-up in the 2023 Rugby World Cup (losing by a single point to South Africa in the final) and returned to Scottish Gas Murrayfield in 2025 for the first time in three years. Last year's epic saw Scotland fight back from being 0-17 down at half-time to level the scores going into the last quarter, only for a couple of moments of brilliance from substitute Damian McKenzie to give the All Blacks the win.

Nations Championship: Round 5

SCOTLAND v AUSTRALIA

Sunday 15 November (Kick-off 3.10pm)

Hosts of the next Rugby World Cup in 2027, Australia are currently 8th in the world rankings, helped by notable wins over South Africa and Argentina in last year's Rugby Championship. The last time they played at Scottish Gas Murrayfield, in November 2024, tries from captain Sione Tuipulotu (in front of his granny who'd been flown over from Australia especially for the game), Duhan van der Merwe and Finn Russell helped Scotland to a 27-13 win.

Nations Championship: Round 6

SCOTLAND v JAPAN

Saturday 21 November (Kick-off 2.10pm)

It's been five years since Japan last visited Edinburgh, when Scotland scored four tries in a 29-20 win. The Brave Blossoms (who famously made the knock-out stages of their own Rugby World Cup in 2019 after a narrow win against Scotland) finished runners-up in last year's Pacific Nations Cup (losing 27-33 to Fiji in the final) and recorded a famous win against Wales and a narrow loss to Australia.

GUINNESS MEN'S SIX NATIONS 2027

Scotland have home advantage for the first two rounds of this season's championship, playing Italy and Wales at Scottish Gas Murrayfield on consecutive weekends before an away trip to France. The final home game is against Ireland in Round 4 (on a Friday night for the first time) with the tournament finishing away to England.

Saturday 6 February (Kick-off 2.10pm)

What an opening game! After the narrow loss in Rome this year in horrendous monsoon conditions, Scotland will be in determined mood to kick off the 2027 championship with a performance more akin to the one at Scottish Gas Murrayfield two years ago when a hat-trick from Player of the Match Huw Jones helped Scotland to an emphatic 31-19 win.

As always, these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis in Category 1 seating in the lower West Stand, so contact us as soon as possible to secure the best available seats.

- Nation Championship match tickets can be purchased during a pre-sale in April/May.
- Guinness Men's Six Nations match tickets can be purchased from May/June to 31 December.

Anyone found to be selling passes or tickets in direct contravention of the ticketing T&Cs will be subject to appropriate sanctions and may be prevented from purchasing any further passes or tickets.

Debenture Hospitality

Murrayfield "C" and "D - Thistle" Debenture holders are offered the opportunity to purchase the official debenture hospitality packages at all games. Packages, which usually start around three hours before kick off and finish an hour after the final whistle, generally include a 3 course meal, drinks before and after the game and food post-match. Hospitality for C Debentures will be located onsite, suite dependant on demand. D debenture hospitality is in the Thistle Suite. Package pricing is available on request.
